Day 01 - Nairobi

You begin your magical holiday today as you board your flight to Kenya - the heart of African safari!! On arrival into Nairobi/Jomo Kenyatta International Airport you are met by Airport Representative and transferred to your hotel. City sightseeing and day free for leisure

01.06.08

Day 02 Nairobi – conference

After breakfast, day free till lunch. Later, attend the conference on your own. Overnight at hotel Panafric.

02.06.08

Day 03 Nairobi - Tree Hotel

After breakfast, leave Nairobi in the morning to arrive the small town of Nyeri in time for a sumptuous lunch at the base hotel before leaving for the tree hotel in the early afternoon. The afternoon is spent watching the early arrival at the waterhole and salt lick, usually antelopes. As the evening progresses, larger animals like elephant and even rhino join the procession to the waterhole. Their appearance would be a signal for smaller animals to depart. The tourist is kept well supplied with hot drinks like tea, coffee or chocolate during the night. In the case of Mountain Lodge you arrive directly at the lodge for lunch. Meals and overnight at a Tree Hotel. You are required to pack an overnight bag when you transfer to the Ark or Treetops for overnight

03.06.08

Day 04 Tree Hotel -Mount Kenya Safari Club

After breakfast a short drive brings you to the Mount Kenya Safari Club, which is situated at the foot of Mt. Kenya (17,058 feet). The elitist membership of this club would include movie stars, aristocrats and politicians, both local and international. Here you can have a day of total relaxation in the beautiful landscaped gardens. Activities include golf, tennis and horseback riding and swimming in the heated swimming pool. Meals and overnight at Mount Kenya Safari Club.

04.06.08

Day 05 Mount Kenya – Nakuru

After breakfast the tour leaves for Nyahururu (Thompson's Falls) at an altitude of 7,738 feet. Then comes the descent into the Rift Valley to Lake Nakuru National park for lunch at one of the hotels. An afternoon drive in the park to enjoy the sight of pelicans bathing in the fresh water streams which terminate in Lake Nakuru. Since there is no existing drainage, Lake Nakuru is alkaline, the perfect place for flamingos to feed on the blue-green algae. Lake Nakuru National Park has a great variety of bird life which includes the Egyptian goose and a variety of ducks that come from Europe in winter. This park is truly a bird watchers paradise. The game animals include hippo, waterbuck, gazelles, Columbus monkeys, buffalo, leopard and the Rothschild giraffe. The park is also a sanctuary for the white rhino. This park has an abundance of acacia trees, both yellow barked (fever tree) the umbrella-topped acacia and the candelabra cactus. Meals and overnight at a lodge in Nakuru/Naivasha. Full board

05.06.08

Day 06 Lake Nakuru/ Naivasha – Masai Mara

There's time after breakfast to enjoy the beauty and tranquility of the lake before leaving for Masai Mara National Reserve where you arrive by lunch time. An afternoon game drive should make it possible to locate the blackmanned lion for which the reserve is famous. Meals and overnight at a lodge in Mara.

Day 07 Masai Mara

A full day's game viewing of Kenya's array of wildlife in their natural habitat. More than 60 species of animals are found here as well as myriad of birds. The vegetation is generally savanna type with clumps of trees near water holes. The rivers are lined with gallery forest. The tourist, who wishes to take an early morning game drive before breakfast, is kept well supplied with hot tea and hot coffee before departure. This trip could be very rewarding as one is most likely to see lion enjoying a kill. Meals and overnight at a lodge in Mara.

Day 08 Masai Mara – Nairobi Airport

After early breakfast, chk out of the hotel. Your sojourn in Kenya ends today as you are picked up and transferred to the Nairobi Airport for you to catch your flight back home
